If you want to improve your English, you'll have to have motivation. Everyone has different goals and ways to achieve them. It depends on what is most important for you. If you or your parents paid for your English college, you must know it's so expensive. It takes a lot of time and energy, not only money, and it determines whether you gain some knowledge or not.

If you really want to know the English language, you have to decide and go for it. We know it's hard, but you can do it!! And we and our advice can you help on your way. But don't forget - your motivation is the engine of your improving.

The first step is to write about your priorities, like learning English, going to school, working, travelling, meeting new people from another countries, etc. Decide how much time (by percent rate) you want to spend doing each thing. However, remember, you can learn English as you do all these things. For this reason, below you are going to find some things that can help you to improve your speaking and listening skills:

For speaking:

- > Try to benefit from your home-stay parents by speaking to them a lot.
- > It's a good idea to read articles and to extract words and expressions from them, and then, make your own new expressions.
- > Try to remember and memorise certain expressions in English every day.
- > When you read articles, make a summary and tell someone in English.
- > If you like to meet new people, the Internet is a good option. There are links where there are people who want to exchange English for your language. (*Editor's note: You could check out www.mychatbuddy.com)
- > Try to identify which expressions you can't translate from your language. Remember, it is not always possible to translate.

For listening:

- > If you want to improve your English listening skills:
- > It's a good idea to listen to the radio with headphones every day, when you are going to school, walking, cooking etc.
- > You can watch and listen to the TV every day.
- > Always listen to people who speak English around you like on the bus, on the street, in restaurants and other places.
- > Try to find special web sites where you can practice listening exercises. (*For example www.elllo.org)
